What is Duty of Care?

- Duty of care means we must keep you safe. We must protect you from harm and act in your best interest.


Our duty of care includes:

- Helping you make safe choices
- Making sure your support is safe and suitable
- Acting if we think you might be in danger

What is Dignity of Risk?

- Dignity of risk means you can make your own choices even if there is some risk. This helps you learn, grow, and live the life you choose.

This includes:

- Choosing how you live your life 
-  Trying new things that are important to you
- Making your own decisions
