What is Feedback?

 Feedback is when you tell us what you think about our services. You can tell us what you like or what we can do better.

What is a Complaint?

 A complaint is when you are not happy with something. You can tell us if something is wrong or if you feel unsafe.


Your Rights





- You have the right to speak up. We will listen and take your feedback or complaint seriously.

You have the right to:

- Be treated with respect
- Be safe and heard
- Complain without being treated badly
- Get help to make a complaint





How You Can Give Feedback or Make a Complaint

-  Call us
-  Email us
-  Fill out a feedback or complaint form

-  Look into what happened
-  Try to fix the problem
