What is Infection Control?

Germes can make people sick. Infection control means doing things to stop germes from spreading.

Why Does It Matter?

What We Do

We will:

- Wash our hands often
- Use hand sanitiser
- Wear gloves when needed
- Wear a mask if we are sick, or if you ask us to
- Clean surfaces and equipment
- Stay home from work if we are sick

What You Can Do

You can:

- Wash your hands often
- Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze
- Tell us if you feel unwell
- Ask us to wear a mask or gloves if you want us to

If a Staff Member Is Sick

If a staff member is sick, they will:

- Stay home
- Tell their manager
- Not come to work until they feel better

If You Are Sick

If you are sick, you can:

- Tell us how you feel
- Ask for extra help if you need it
- We will still support you safely
